## **PHASE IV BEGINS. Doors unlocked Monday-Friday 9-5:30, Saturday 9-2.**

- **Browsing is now available for magazines and DVDs**, in addition to new fiction, non-fiction, and large-print. When browsing the DVD section, if you pull a DVD to look at, place it in the box on the table, where it will be sanitized before we re-shelve it.
- **30-minute reservations may be made for computer use**, which will be sanitized between patrons. A mask is required for this; if you don't have one of your own, we have disposable masks available for your use.
- **Imagine Your Story!** This summer reading program for children birth-age 12 will be online (talk to a children's librarian if you prefer to participate on paper) using the Beanstack program at our website and/or via an app for your phone, where you can register, log your reading minutes, earn badges and prizes, and learn about our outdoor programming schedule. Three grand prizes will be available, one for each age group (birth-4, ages 5-8, and ages 9-12).
- Adhering to mask and social distance protocols while in the library is appreciated.

## **BACK ON TRACK**

The library has aligned its reopening plan with the state's Back on Track plan, which is in Stage 4 from June 12 through at least July 3, subject to change per CDC guidance and other new information.

**Here is a summary of our services available during this phase:**

- Limited browsing onsite; online resources, materials; Wi-Fi access; holds pickup curbside or in the library
- Remote printing via Princh (use app for Android or iOS, or go to [print.princh.com](http://print.princh.com); enter printer ID 102822; upload documents and adjust print settings; pay online or at the library). Letter, legal, and ledger pages are 20 cents each.

- **AfternoonZoom with The Amazing Lit Society** for 4th-8th graders; currently reading *The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe* together by C.S. Lewis, along with other activities.
