Hey kids! Join us at the Hartford City Public Library for a fun summer of reading, games, and entertainment! Here's how our summer reading program works:

1. Sign up in the children's area starting May 30. Age groups are Birth-4, 5-9, and 10-14 .
2. Start logging your reading beginning June 6. You will be given a log sheet when you sign up.
3. At the end of each week of reading, bring in your log showing your completed weekly reading requirement.
4. Choose a prize and a ticket to put in our weekly or grand prize drawings OR choose to place two tickets in the weekly or grand prize drawings—it's up to you!
5. In addition you will be given a BINGO card. Complete the activities needed to make a BINGO and bring your card into the library for an extra ticket to place in our weekly or grand prize drawings. Play as many times as you like and keep putting entries into the drawing!

There will be three grand prizes given at the end of the six week summer reading program, one for each age group, and also prizes given weekly for those participating in the weekly drawing.

The Silver Lining Book Club

The HCPL Children's Library participates in the Silver Lining program offered by Community & Family Services and the Presbyterian Church. By participating, families can earn coupons toward items at the Silver Lining Opportunity Store! Here's how it works: A parent needs to be a Blackford County resident and have a library card to participate. Each family reads five books in a week and records them on a sheet offered in the children's department to earn one (1) coupon a week. A second coupon can be earned each week by attending a Story and Craft Time (on Wednesdays). You may choose to earn one coupon a week for either reading or attending Story & Craft Time, or you may do both to earn two (2) coupons each week. The choice is yours! The Silver Lining Opportunity Store is open on the 2nd Saturday of each month at the Presbyterian Church. They offer many items for children including diapers, formula, clothing, bedding, toiletries, etc. Even just one (1) coupon can buy an item!

1,000 Books Before Kindergarten

1,000 Books Before Kindergarten is a FREE library program that encourages all parents and families to read 1,000 books with their young children before they enter kindergarten. Studies have shown that families who start reading aloud to their children at birth help to strengthen their language skills and build their vocabulary – two important tools for beginning to learn to read when they enter kindergarten.

1,000 Books? Does it sound difficult? It shouldn't if you give it some thought! If you read one book at bedtime every night for three years, you will have read 1,095 books! If you read three books a day, you will have read 1,095 books in one year. If you begin when your child is born and read four books per week, you will have read 1,040 books by the time your child reaches kindergarten.

How Does 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten Work?

Requirements – You must be a resident of Blackford County and have an established Evergreen Indiana Library card.

Register – Complete an enrollment form and return it to the Hartford City Public Library. You may then take home your starter kit.

Track Your Reading – Each time you read a book with your child, write it down on the log sheets inside your reading binder (included in the starter kit).

Show us your Reading Logs – When you reach 100 books, bring in your reading log sheets, and receive a prize! Each 100 books increment will be rewarded with a prize. Read More Books! When you get all the way to 1,000, your child will receive a canvas book-bag along with a new book of his or her choice. We will also place a picture of your child on our "Wall of Fame" to show which children have completed the program.
