### January 18, 2023 minutes - regular meeting

## **ANNUAL FINANCE BOARD MEETING**

- 1. Michael Tabor was elected president of the Finance Board.
- Judy requested research into whether CDs would be a good financial vehicle for some
  amount of savings that could be set aside for earnings rather than keeping entirety in noninterest bearing checking account.
- 3. Michele said that, once we have closed the construction account and have the end-of-year financials complete, that Jen and she would look into both investments and benefits of moving all accounts to VIA instead of having them split between CSB and VIA.

MINUTES of the December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022 meeting were approved as moved by Dave and seconded by Kelli, which carried 7-0.

### **FINANCIAL REPORTS:**

- 1. There is still a slight discrepancy between funds and Citizens balance to be worked out on reconcilement and funds summary reports; corrected reports will be sent out. Balances, however, are quite healthy after December disbursement.
- 2. Michele provided an annual summary of receipts from the county auditor.
- 3. Townships are all paid up. Washington will get contract signed and returned as soon as board seats are filled.

### **CIRCULATION REPORT:**

- 1. Numbers are a bit lower but not too bad. More patrons and community members are coming in to use the various spaces.
- 2. Judy asked which museum passes are available. Michele listed the following:
  - a. Minnetrista
  - b. Muncie Children's Museum
  - c. Indiana State Museum and various historical sites around the state
- 3. Regarding the annual materials report, digital materials are circulating quite well, and other materials seem to be picking up post-phases of Covid and construction.

- 2. Amy had several in attendance for the weekly Explorer's Story Time and Page Turners Book Club, and is gearing up to offer winter reading in January-February.
